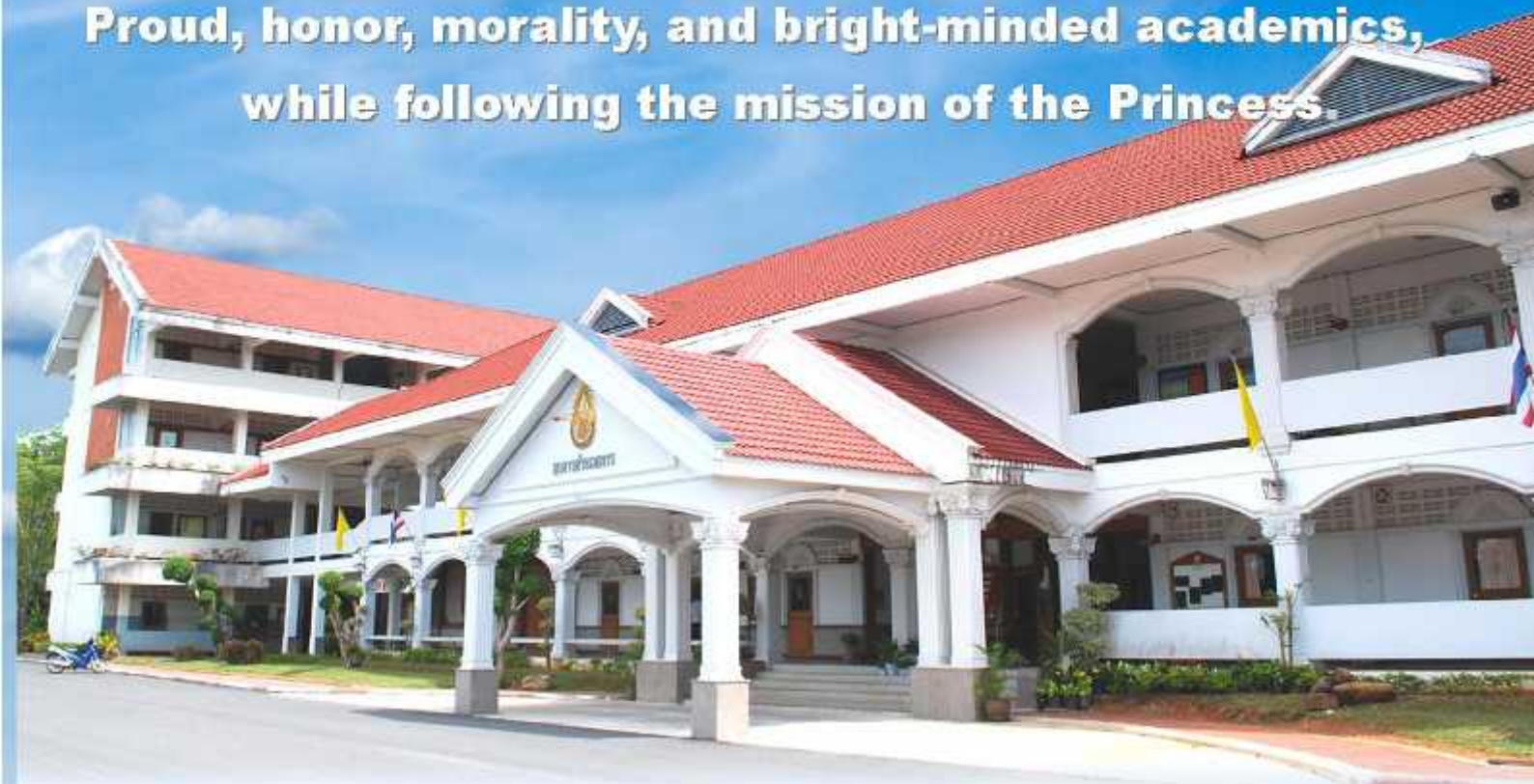




Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Nakhon Si Thammarat

The school has a 3 – year program at the junior high school level (grade 7 to 9) and also a 3 - year program at the senior high school level (grade 10 - 12). All programs are specialized and intensive in mathematics and science. It is a co-education and boarding school. All students receive full scholarships from the government. There are 24 students per class. The full capacity is 720 students with 4 classes per year at the junior level and 6 classes per year at the senior level.

Only students who have excellent academic achievements in mathematics and science are qualified to apply for a place in the school and students in the assigned neighboring provinces only are qualified to apply for Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Nakhon Si Thammarat

Wat Phra Mahathat Woramaha Vihan

Wat Phra Mahathat Woramaha Vihan is the most important temple of Nakhon Si Thammarat and southern part of Thailand. It was constructed at the time of the founding of the town, and contains a tooth relic of the Buddha. The 78 m high chedi is surrounded by 173 smaller ones. While the chedi is now in Sri Lankan style, it is said to be built on top of an earlier Srivijaya style chedi. The chedi completed a renovation in early 2009 and now appears like new
